Departmental Update

- ▶ Authorized 53 sworn officers, 24 Non-sworn
 - ▶ Current 50 officers
 - ▶ Patrol
 - ▶ Investigations
 - ▶ Traffic
 - ▶ SAT (Special Assignment Team)
 - ▶ CAT (Community Policing, CIT, SRO, Franklin Park Partnership)
 - ▶ Non Sworn
 - ▶ Dispatch
 - ▶ Records
 - ▶ Administration
 - ▶ Animal Services
 - ▶ Parking Enforcement

Crime Statistics Year To Date

- ▶ Overall, Crime is up 34%
- ▶ Violent Crime is flat from 2022.
 - ▶ Carjacking is down 47%
 - ▶ Assault is down 7%
 - ▶ Citizen robbery is up from 31 YTD 2022 to 42 YTD
- ▶ Property Crime is up 6%
- ▶ Vehicle theft is up 465%
 - ▶ 61% of vehicles stolen are Hyundai or Kia

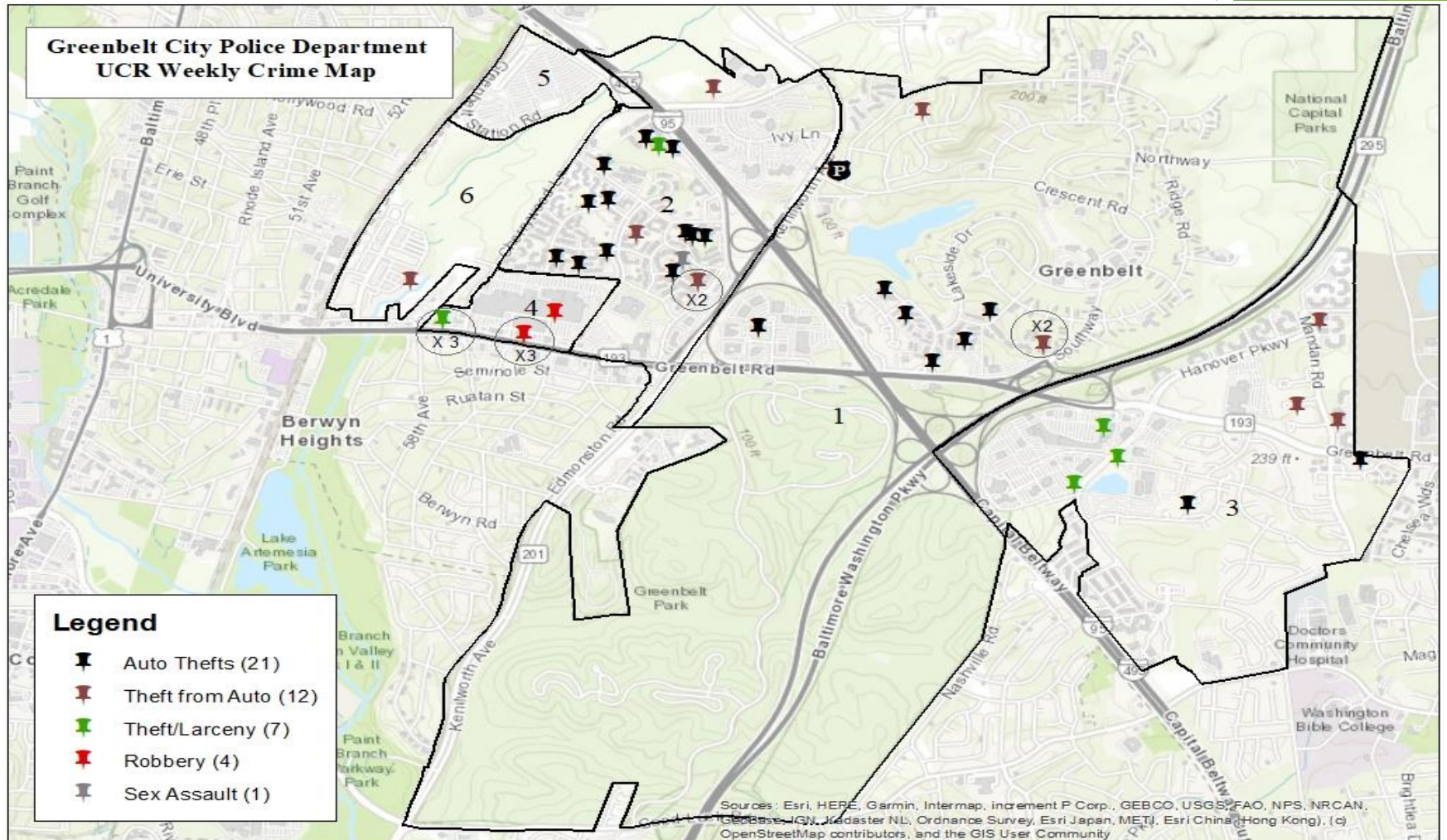

Juvenile Crime Increase

- ▶ Juvenile arrests have increased from 2022
 - ▶ 2023 year to date 47
 - ▶ 2022 total 7
- ▶ Juveniles arrested multiple times
- ▶ Juvenile Justice Act limits accountability
- ▶ Child Interrogation Protection Act

Department Actions

- ▶ The department is focused on deploying Officers to respond to increased juvenile crime and repeat violent offenders.
- ▶ The department is planning for a youth services officer position in the community policing team.
 - ▶ Conduct follow-up with at-risk youth and parents before involvement with the criminal justice system
 - ▶ Serve as the department advocate and point of contact with Juvenile services for cases involving repeat offenders
- ▶ Partnership with U.S. Marshalls Service in the regional fugitive task force. The task force is focused on the apprehension of violent fugitives.

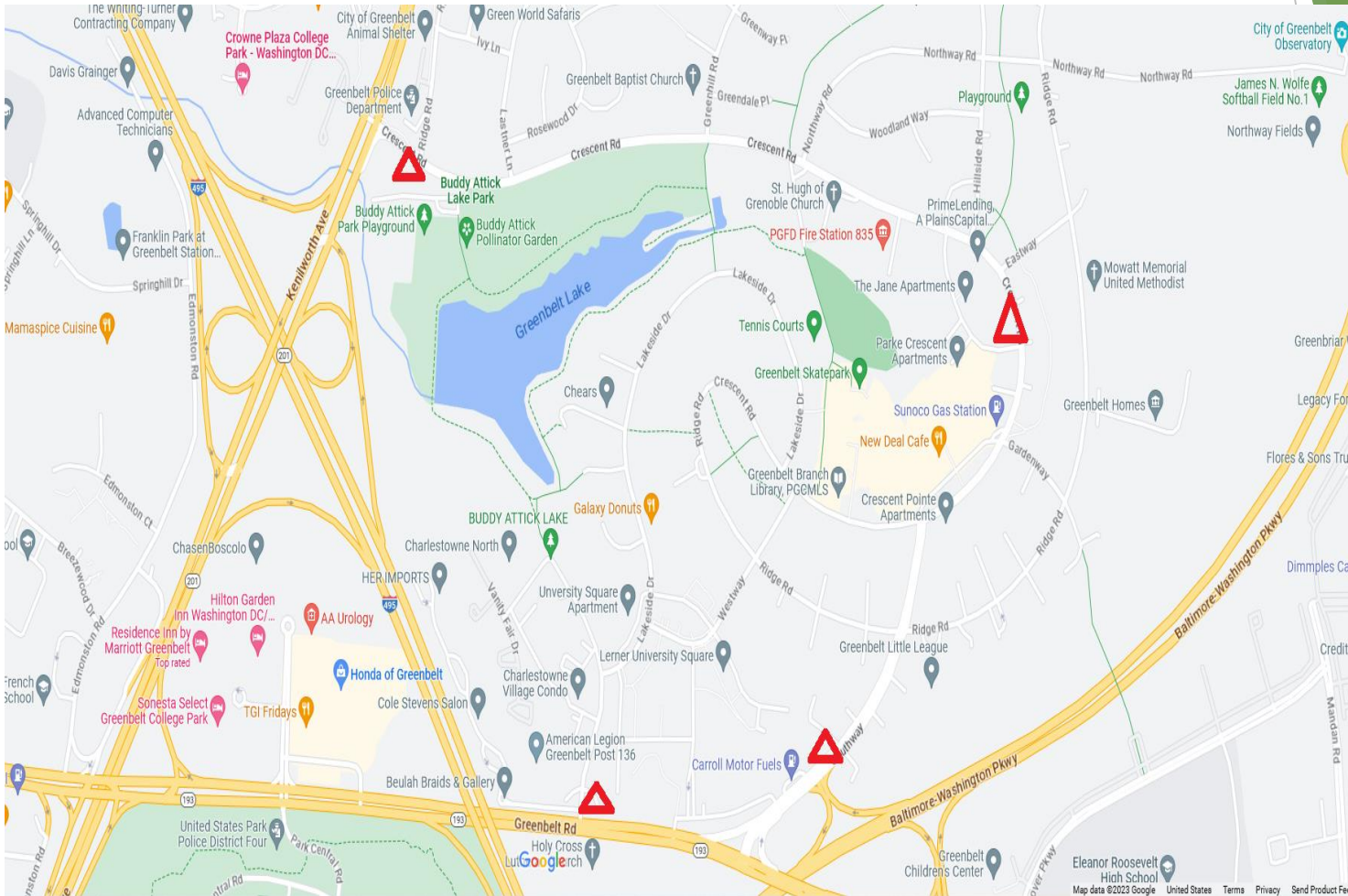
Department Actions Technology

- ▶ The department is exploring the use of cameras.
 - ▶ The deployment of license plate reading cameras at critical locations.
 - ▶ The deployment of cameras at documented hot spots.
