

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE GREENBELT CITY COUNCIL held Monday, July 30, 2012.

Mayor Pro Tem Jordan called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

ROLL CALL was answered by Councilmembers Konrad E. Herling, Leta M. Mach, Silke I. Pope, Edward V. J. Putens, Rodney M. Roberts and Mayor Pro Tem Emmett V. Jordan. Mayor Judith F. Davis was out of town visiting family before they returned to China.

ALSO PRESENT were Michael McLaughlin, City Manager; David E. Moran, Assistant City Manager; and Cindy Murray, City Clerk.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: It was moved by Ms. Pope and seconded by Mr. Putens that the agenda be approved. The motion passed 6-0.

COMMUNITY CLINIC, INC. – FRANKLIN PARK: Mayor Pro Tem Jordan read the agenda comments.

Dr. William Flynt, Community Clinic, Inc. (CCI) advised that CCI had submitted a request to Prince George's County to provide \$500,000 in funding for the CCI's health services center in Franklin Park. He reported they had received a verbal commitment of \$300,000 from the County late Friday. Dr. Flynt commented that although this is \$200,000 short of what had been requested, he was pleased with the substantial County commitment and was hopeful their support would encourage approval of funding applications pending at two Managed Care Organizations and an area hospital. He advised in total they were seeking \$2.3 million and had commitments of \$1.02 million at this time.

Mr. Roberts moved that Council send a letter to County Executive Baker indicating support for the proposal by Community Clinic, Inc. (CCI) to construct, equip, and operate a health services center in Franklin Park, thank the County for their \$300,000 commitment to assist CCI, and urge the County to consider providing an additional amount up to \$200,000. Ms. Pope seconded.

After discussion, Council agreed to copy the County letter to the 4-Cities Coalition and also send a generic letter of support for CCI to reference when seeking additional support.

The motion passed 6-0.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion to adjourn the special meeting was made by Mr. Putens and seconded by Ms. Mach. The motion passed 6-0.

Mayor Pro Tem Jordan adjourned the special meeting of Monday, July 30, 2012, at 7:45 p.m.
