

*WORK SESSION OF THE GREENBELT CITY COUNCIL held Wednesday, May 15, 2013, for the purpose of reviewing the Green Ridge House section of the Proposed FY 2014 Budget.*

*Mayor Davis started the meeting at 7:30 p.m. It was held in the Dining Room at Green Ridge House*

*PRESENT WERE: Councilmembers Konrad E. Herling, Emmett V. Jordan, Leta M. Mach, Silke I. Pope, Edward V.J. Putens and Mayor Judith F. Davis. Councilmember Rodney M. Roberts was detained at work and arrived at 7:36 p.m.*

*STAFF PRESENT WERE: Michael P. McLaughlin, City Manager, and Cindy Murray, City Clerk.*

*ALSO PRESENT WERE: Lynnette McGrath, Kim Potts, and Patty Ramsburg of Community Realty.*

*Mr. McLaughlin reviewed the accomplishments for FY 13 and the highlights of the proposed FY 14 budget including planned capital expenses. Council then reviewed the Green Ridge House section of the budget.*

*There was discussion regarding the emergency generator. Ms. McGrath reported the generator provides power to the elevator, emergency lights and emergency outlets, but does not provide power to the individual apartments. She added there are enough emergency outlets to accommodate all the residents in need of oxygen. Nancy McCord suggested the purchase of a larger generator that would provide power to all the apartments be considered for purchase in the future.*

*A resident reported that she had observed vehicles parked in handicap parking spaces for up to three weeks without being moved and asked if there was a policy about use of these spaces. Ms. McGrath said there is a one week limit on parking a vehicle in a handicap space without moving it. It was recommended that notice of the policy be provided to all residents.*

*John Snead thanked Council for its contribution to the Green Ridge House Residents Association.*

*Mayor Davis and Council thanked everyone for attending.*
