

WORK SESSION OF THE GREENBELT CITY COUNCIL held Wednesday, February 11, 2015.

Mayor Jordan called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. It was held in Room 201 of the Greenbelt Community Center.

PRESENT WERE: Councilmembers Judith F. Davis, Konrad E. Herling, Leta M. Mach, Silke I. Pope Rodney M. Roberts, and Mayor Emmett V. Jordan. Councilmember Edward V.J. Putens was unable to attend due to a work commitment.

STAFF PRESENT WERE: Michael McLaughlin, City Manager; Karen Ruff, Associate of the City Solicitor; and Cindy Murray, City Clerk.

Informational Items

Ms. Mach asked about walkways at Stream Valley Park. Mr. McLaughlin said staff had obtained a cost estimate and the project will be discussed during the budget process.

Ms. Pope asked when the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC) survey stakes in Buddy Attick Park would be removed. Mr. McLaughlin estimated about two weeks but said staff will check with WSSC.

Mayor Jordan advised that he had received an email from Kap Kapastin regarding plans for the theaters at Beltway Plaza. He said he would forward the email to Councilmembers.

Ms. Davis provided an update on the Maryland Municipal League Legislative Committee Meeting.
